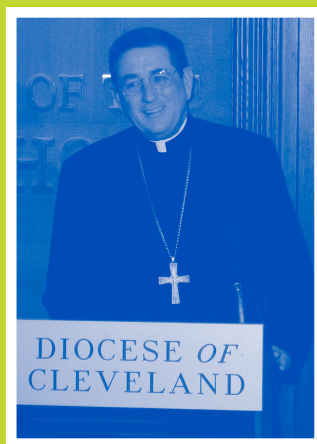




CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

EAST SIDE ORGANIZING PREDATORY LENDING PROJECT (ESOP) is impacting sub-prime lending in some east-Cleveland neighborhoods and engaging citizens to advocate for stronger state and federal regulations.

CATHOLIC STUDENTS FOR PEACE AND JUSTICE PROJECT exposes high school age students to current social justice

issues by engaging them in leadership development and advocacy techniques.
