These pictures of Grand Boulage were taken by Myriam, a veterinarian who was traveling up to the mountain village when the quake hit. They were traveling over the rough roads and didn't know a quake was occurring until they saw the buildings falling.

Assumption Haiti Outreach has established a partnering relationship with the people of this mountain village in the Thomazeau region and mission teams visit there regularly.

Initial reports received soon after the earthquake indicated that Thomazeau and Grand Boulage had not suffered major damage. Later information, however, estimated that **13,000 homes had been either damaged or destroyed**. With the utter devastation that struck Port au Prince, it is uncertain how and when help will get to the people in the countryside.
