Sign-Up Dates:

All Completed Registration Forms are **due by Monday, March 3, 2008**. All fees should be included with the registration forms. All physical forms **MUST** be completed by March 3rd. **NO ATHLETE WILL BE PERMITTED TO PRACTICE WITHOUT PAID REGISTRATIONS AND A PHYSICAL FORM after 3/3/08.** If you are having a problem with either your fees or your physicals, please contact Sue Klemenc to make further arrangements.

Note: If you have sent in a pre-registration form, you are guaranteed a spot on a team if available provided that you return these forms by 3/3/08. Athletes registering after 3/03/08 may be placed on a Waiting list. All late registrants will be assessed a \$5.00 Late fee.

Eligibility Requirements:

- All participants must be a student registered and participating In the St. Justin Martyr PSR Program, a parishioner at St. Mary Magdalene Parish or enrolled in the SMM-SJM Day School in the fall of 2007 to participate in the Spring CYO Sports Program

Fundraisers:

All parents of athletes are required to sell one box of candy per family. A \$20.00 buy out fee is available instead of selling candy. Checks should be made payable to: SMM-SJM Athletic Association. Makes sure you indicate on the check it is for the candy.

Fees:

- \$45.00 per Athlete for each sport
(If paid on or before 3/03/08)
- \$50.00 per Athlete for each sport
(If paid after 3/03/08)
- \$5.00 /child/per sport discount for each Additional child that is registered in the same family in the same sport

- \$50.00 uniform deposit for Track
(This is a separate check made payable to the SMM-SJM Athletic Association. These checks will not be cashed unless an athlete fails to return his or her uniform, or if the uniform is not returned in the same condition that the child received it.)

Games and Practice Schedules:

- All athletes are required to attend all practices and games (Meets) unless the Coach has excused them.
- All athletes must be willing to commit to this team and to attending all practices due to small team numbers, if athletes are missing, it causes unproductive practices and possible forfeiture of games. This penalizes the whole team.
- All athletes must be “coachable” and willing to be a team player. This means that when he/she comes to practices and/or games, she must be ready and willing to learn and play the game of basketball.
- Practice schedules will be set as soon as sign ups are complete and the teams have been established.
- Play Time will be awarded in accordance with CYO Rules. In addition **Coaches have the right to limit playtime based on an athlete’s attendance at practice and his or her conduct.**
- Game Schedules are not available at this time. These are set by the CYO Athletic Office and will not be determined until the last week of March. The Spring Games are scheduled to begin on or after 4/02/08

Uniform Policy:

All athletes are required by CYO to wear a standardized Uniform. This will be providing for by the SMM-SJM Athletic Association unless otherwise noted. These uniforms are to be worn to games or scrimmages (as dictated by the coach) only. No part of the uniform should be worn any other situations such as gym class, etc. These uniforms are very expensive and should be treated with respect. For example, football uniforms cost about \$250.00 and cheerleader uniforms cost about \$100.00 per uniform.

All uniforms will be distributed to the athletes after the Official practices begin and before the first game. Each athlete will receive a uniform only if the following criteria are met:

- all participation fees have been paid.
- A uniform deposit has been paid.
- A valid physical form that is signed on both the front and back with all information complete.

Physical/ Emergency Medical Forms:

- All athletes are required to have an annual physical. The Physician must fill out the official form and sign it.
- If your child has had a physical within the last year, your physician may opt to fill out this form with out performing another exam.
- If your child participated in a CYO 2007 Fall or Winter Sport, Programs he/she may use that form to qualify for the Spring Sports Program providing the date is valid. **All physicals expire one year after the date the physical form is signed by the physician. If your physical expires before 5/31/08 you MUST get a new physical.**
- If you participated in a **CYO Programs at another Parish** YOU are responsible for getting a copy of that physical. **If your physical expires before 5/31/08 you MUST get a new physical.**
- **Please make sure that all of the physical forms are:**
 - * **Signed by both the athlete and parent**
 - * The emergency medical information on the Reverse side of the physical form must be completed
 - * All forms are required to have the name of your **insurance company** as well as the **Policy number listed on your insurance card**. If you do not have insurance, you must submit a letter acknowledging your financial responsibility in the event that the athlete should require medical attention.
