Who are Stephen Ministers? They are your neighbors and friends, your fellow parishioners and maybe even your relatives. They are male and female, young and old, from every walk of life. They are caring individuals who take their Baptismal Call seriously. They have sacrificed to take a training course and they attend supervision meetings twice a month.

Their work is **CONFIDENTIAL**, and that is why you don't hear much about it. We currently have four persons in the training class. They are **Dolores Babuscak, Jeanette Butler, Robert Kirsch and Dick Mulcahy**. These four people have spent countless hours preparing for their new ministry.

Who will they serve? Stephen Ministers serve anyone who is hurting in any way and who requests a Stephen Minister to help them through the difficult time. Others served by Stephen Ministers include people who are suffering losses in their lives: perhaps a loved one has died or another member of the family is seriously ill and the care giver needs support from someone like a Stephen Minister. Whatever the hurt, we have caring persons to listen and be a loving presence.
